Instructions for Oral and e-Poster Submissions

Important Dates

- Abstract Submission deadline: 31 May 2023

Abstract Submission Instructions

- Abstracts shall be submitted electronically through the Congress website.
- The abstract must be written in English.
- Abstracts for the Oral, video, and e-Poster presentation are limited to 250 words.
- One table and/or one image may be included in the abstract
- Tables/Images must be placed at the end of your abstract.
- Abstracts that have been previously presented at national meetings can be submitted to A-PHPBA.
- Work presented at national meetings or international meetings other than A-PHPBA may also be submitted to A-PHPBA.
- Work that has previously been presented at A-PHPBA should not be re-submitted.
- For clinical work, it is encouraged that all work should have been reviewed and approved by institutional or regional ethics boards and that all co-authors must be familiar with the final submitted abstract.
- Concerning basic science work, it is obligatory to provide a statement in the text of the abstract confirming the ethics committee review of work.
- All successful abstract presenters will be notified and must register for the meeting.
- Late submissions after 31 May 2023 will **not** be accepted.

Structure:

The abstracts should be structured in the following four sections:

- Introduction: indicates the purpose of the study
- Methods: describe pertinent experimental procedures
- Results: summarize the results of the research
- Conclusion: state the main conclusions

The authors should choose one topic only for every abstract submitted. If an abstract relates to more than one of the topics below, please select the most appropriate one.

General Information

- It is the submitting author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar, or scientific fact will be published as typed by the author if accepted. Poor English may be a cause for rejection.
- If you do not complete the submission process, your information will be held in "draft" until you return later to complete your submission. Please note that your abstract must be fully submitted, before the deadline of **31 May 2023**, to be considered for Congress.
- Changes to the abstract are possible until **31 May 2023** through your personal "My Submissions" page, which can be accessed with the link included in the electronic acknowledgment of receipt.
- The submitting author will receive all correspondence concerning the abstract and is responsible for informing the other co-authors of the status of the abstract.
- Notification of acceptance/rejection of the abstracts will be emailed to the submitting author. Full Oral presentation specifications will be made available on the website and forwarded with the abstract acceptance.
- e-Poster presentation will be uploaded in advance of the Congress. Further details will be provided with the acceptance notifications.
- Upon acceptance of the abstract, all presenting authors are expected to register and present their abstract in person at the Congress.
